The parties in this case are spouses to each-other.

2. The petitioner happens to be respondent in the original matrimonial petition filed by the present respondent under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 seeking dissolution of marriage between them.

3. During the course of hearing, learned Additional District Judge, Sangrur on 27.11.2018, while recording the statements of RW-3 SI Harjeet Kaur, in examination-in-chief, had recorded in the deposition sheet:-

“At this stage, counsel for the respondent requested to defer further examination-in-chief because the report of witness regarding chatting is necessary and after the receipt of report of witness regarding chatting is necessary and after the receipt of report chief is only be completed (SIC).....

Request declined that the report of witness should have (SIC) produced in the court before issuance of summoning order”.

4. The present petitioner/wife is aggrieved by this observation recorded in the deposition sheet.

5. It, however, transpires that in a separate Civil Revision No.8409 of 2018, filed by the petitioner/wife, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court has now granted her liberty to complete the evidence from her side, which is reported to have been closed in the *interregnum* on 04.10.2018 the Trial Court, within a period of two months from today.

6. In the given circumstances, no tangible cause of action to pursue the present revisional application survives as in any case the request for time which was declined vide the impugned observations, has virtually been now allowed by a Co-ordinate bench in the above referred Revision Petition.

7. Therefore, the present revision is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
