The petitioner is in the revision petition against the order passed by the learned Additional District Judge, permitting the certain documents to be produced on file as a additional evidence, however, declining the prayer made by the petitioner to file a report dated 08.08.2017 claimed to have been prepared by Patwari of the area, determining the possession of the parties.

The Court has noticed that the present case is with regard to the assessment of the market value of the land compulsorily acquired under the National Highway Act, 1956. The Court has noticed that such report would have no relevance for the purpose of decision of the case.

It is not disputed before this Court that the parties are co-sharers in the joint khata. Some portion of the joint khata has been acquired.

Such being the position, this Court does not find any good ground to interfere with the impugned order passed.

Revision petition is dismissed.
