ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner husband is aggrieved by an order dated 17.11.2017, vide which his application to transfer the divorce proceedings from the Court of Smt. Preeti Sahni, Additional District Judge, Jalandhar, has since been dismissed.

The limited ground upon which the petitioner had prayed for transfer of the proceedings was; that while posted as Chief Judicial Magistrate at Hoshiarpur, the said Judicial Officer had convicted the petitioner for three years and, therefore, he was apprehensive that he would not get justice from the said Court.

In my considered view, the ground upon which the petitioner is seeking transfer of the proceedings is wholly misconceived and untenable. If year's ago, an Officer decided some matter in discharge of her judicial functions that could hardly be a reason to seek transfer of the proceedings.

Particularly, in the absence of any cogent and compelling reason which justifies such a prayer.

No ground is made out to interfere in exercise of revisional jurisdiction under Article 227 of the Constitution of India. The petition is accordingly dismissed.
