Challenge in the present revision petition is the order dated 10.11.2017 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, vide which the application for dismissal of the suit filed by the petitioner was dismissed. Petitioner wants the suit to be dismissed on the ground that he has made the entire payment. The lower court has taken the view that it cannot be decided at this stage.

I agree with the view taken by the lower court that full payment is to be decided after parties lead evidence.
