On the last date of hearing, the petitioner was directed to bring into notice of this Court as to whether the amount of ₹44,319/- was allegedly disbursed to his brother/respondent No.2-Balbir Singh after 04.10.2010, on which date learned Additional Sessions Judge (Ad hoc) Fast Track Court, Amritsar had ordered to convert the same into FDR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to comply with the said direction. Therefore, the instant petition is dismissed with a cost of ₹10,000/- for want of prosecution and for wasting precious time of this Court as well as of the courts below, inasmuch as there also he did not lead any such evidence, rather he went on pursuing his contempt petition without bringing on record the actual date of alleged disbursement of the aforesaid amount in favour of his brother/respondent No.2-Balbir Singh.

Copy of this order be sent to the Member Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Amritsar, who is directed to recover the said cost from the petitioner.
