1. This order will dispose of the above captioned writ petitions, as common questions of law and facts are involved in them which can conveniently be decided by a common order.

2. CWP No.1905 of 1994 was admitted on 17.05.1994 to be heard with CWP No.2536 of 1994. Similarly, CWP No.15297 of 1994 was admitted on 26.09.1994 to be heard with CWP No.1905 of 1994. CWP No.2536 of 1994 together with other connected petitions bearing CWP No.14624 of 1992 and CWP No.1458 of 1993, wherein also challenge is to

the seniority list of Naib Tehsildars circulated on 05.10.1992, was dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. This Court in lead case i.e. CWP No.14624 of 1992 titled 'Om Parkash Sharma Vs. The State of Haryana & others' decided on 05.11.2014 passed the following order:

“This order will dispose of CWP Nos. 14624 of 1992, 1458 of 1993 and 2536 of 1994, as common questions of law and facts are involved.

Challenge in the bunch of petitions is to the seniority list of Naib Tehsildars circulated on 5.10.1992.

It is not in dispute that the petitioners in all the aforesaid petitions have retired after attaining the age of superannuation. The issue is no more required to be gone into.

Accordingly, the writ petitions are dismissed as infructuous.

It is made clear that dismissal of the writ petitions as infructuous will not, in any way, affect the retiral dues being drawn by the petitioners.”

3. Accordingly, the instant petitions are disposed of in terms of *Om Parkash Sharma's* case.
