The prayer is for grant of higher pay scale i.e. J.S.T grade on the basis of instructions issued by respondent No.1 vide memo dated 11.01.1990 (Annexure P-9).

Heard.

As per record, the minimum eligibility for claiming the JST grade is graduation. At the time of induction of the petitioner in service, he did not possess the requisite qualification for JST grade and subsequently he acquired the JST grade on 20.11.1970 and on the same day, the relief was allowed to him, therefore, no cause of action has arisen as of now.

As the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
