Lalit Batra, J. (Oral) :

Despite the fact that notices were sent to petitioners as well as their counsel and case has been called but no body has turned up on behalf of petitioners.

In compliance of order dated 2.11.2018, learned State counsel has placed on record affidavit of Chief Engineer/Canals, Water Resources Department, Punjab, Chandigarh, of even date, in terms of which complete details especially in respect the posts/designation held by petitioners and respondents No.2 to 9 at the time of their retirement have been given. Further a bare perusal of affidavit reveals that petitioners as well as respondents No.2 to 9 have already retired on attaining the age of superannuation except for respondent No.2.

Learned State counsel submits that respondent No.2-Arvinder Singh

retired at the age of 60 years after having been given extension in service of two years as per policy of Government.

In view of the above since no one has turned up on behalf of petitioners, instant writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
