This application has been filed for suspension of sentence of the applicant/appellant-Pargat Singh son of Pritam Singh, during pendency of the appeal. He has been convicted under section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, and has been sentenced to undergo RI for a period of two years and to pay fine of Rs.10,000/-, in default of payment of fine, to further undergo RI for a period of one month.

2. Keeping in view the fact that the maximum sentence of applicant/appellant is RI for two years and that the appeal is not likely to be decided at an early date as also in view of the judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court, in *Siddarth Jain Vs. State (NCT) of Delhi 2009(2) RCR (Criminal) 764*, the application is allowed and the sentence of applicant- Pargat Singh son of Pritam Singh is suspended during the pendency of appeal. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar.
