Tarsem Kumar, the injured filed the appeal seeking enhancement of compensation in respect of injuries sustained by him in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 27.10.1999.

The Tribunal has awarded compensation of Rs.7000/- in view of discussion made in paras 19 to 22 of the award.

As the appellant has failed to cause appearance in person or through a representative despite intimation sent by Registry of the Court in compliance with order dated 02.08.2018, Sh. Sanjeev Kodan, Advocate, present in the Court, is appointed as Amicus Curiae to assist the Court on behalf of the claimant.

Counsel for the appellant would urge that the injured sustained three injuries detailed in para 2 of the grounds of appeal, in the occurrence dated 27.10.1999 for which he remained admitted in the hospital for a period of 12 to 13 days till 09.11.1999. It is argued that compensation allowed by the Tribunal is inadequate and liable to be enhanced.

I have gone through findings of the Tribunal on issue No.2

particularly observations recorded in paras 19 and 20 of the award but find myself unable to accept contention of the appellant that there is any justification for allowing compensation over and above what has been assessed by the Tribunal.

In view of what has been discussed hereinabove, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed.
