In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for quashing FIR No.111 dated 31.08.2007 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Khamano.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 3.8.2018, parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre for the purpose of amicable settlement among the parties. On 21.9.2018, parties have entered into a settlement/compromise. Copy of the settlement/compromise dated 21.9.2018 has been forwarded by the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court vide communication dated 21.9.2018.

3. In view of the above development, present petition do not survive for consideration.

4. In view of the law laid down in **Anita Maria Dias and another v. State of Maharashtra and another**; (2018) 3 SCC 290, no useful purpose would be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, FIR No.111 dated 31.08.2007 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Khamano is quashed subject to payment of cost of Rs.5000/- by the petitioner. Cost shall be remitted in the District Treasury

Fatehgarh Sahib, State of Punjab within a period of three months. Quashing of FIR is subject to compliance of the compromise dated 21.9.2018. Both the parties remain bound by the compromise.

5. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
