1. The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allot the industrial plot in the focal point at Dhandari Kalan, Ludhiana, in view of the policy framed by the respondents and to declare the allotments made by the respondents in the year 1994 on the basis of alleged comparison of merits. Further prayer has also been made to set aside the public notice dated 02.11.1996 (Annexure P-6) issued by respondent No.3 as well as the draw of lots which were held on 08.11.1996 in lieu of the said notice.

2. On 23.08.2017, time was granted to learned counsel for the petitioner to seek instructions as to whether anything survives in the writ petition or not.
3. In context thereto, learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to give the requisite information.
4. In view of the above, the present writ petition stands dismissed for want of prosecution. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to apply for revival of the writ petition, in case something survives therein.
