Though an allegation with regard to stealing of timber logs has also been made in the FIR, the rest of the dispute, *prima facie* atleast, would seem to be with regard to the petitioners having allegedly occupied an extra portion of the plot, i.e. some feet more than that they had purchased, vide the sale deed dated 04.04.1985.

Looking at the nature of the dispute, without making any comment on the correctness or otherwise of the allegations made against the petitioners, which would be gone into by the investigating agency and the competent Court at the appropriate stage, on the basis of evidence gathered/led, this petition is disposed of with the order dated 09.03.2018, admitting the petitioners to interim bail, made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
