Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the agreement (Annexure P-1), by which one Bhagat Singh transferred his 1/3rd share in the stone crusher to the petitioner, and a subsequent agreement (not on record) by which respondent no.5 is also stated to have transferred his share to the petitioner, a false FIR has been got registered by respondent no.5 against the petitioner, on the basis of which the petitioner is being harassed by the police (as alleged). (Even a copy of the FIR has not been annexed with the petition).

Without making any comment on the allegations made by the petitioner in this petition, it is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2, i.e. the SSP, Ropar, to go into the matter and to ensure that action is taken only as per law and that the petitioner is not harassed if he is not even *prima facie* found guilty of any offence.
