The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.171 dated 15.05.2014 registered under Sections 313/406/498-A of IPC at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, District Ambala, deleted Section 313 IPC later on and the consequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Report has been received from the trial Court after statements of the parties were recorded regarding the compromise. The trial Court has reported that the compromise is voluntary, with their free will and without any pressure etc. The trial Court has also sent copies of statements of the parties and compromise.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that petitioners No.1 to 4 are the accused persons and respondent no.2 is the only aggrieved person in this FIR. He further submits that petitioners No.3 and 4 were found to be innocent.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending.

In view of the statements and report of the trial Court and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof are quashed.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements made in the Court below.
