AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the present petition. He, however, states that the petitioner was arrested on 09.07.2015 and out of 17 witnesses nominated by the prosecution, only 4 have been examined till date. Petitioner is a young boy of 20 years of age and was a student of 10th Class prior to his arrest. He, therefore, prays that the trial be expedited.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the observation that the trial Court would make an effort that the prosecution examines its witnesses at an early date.
