Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under
Section 438 Cr.P.C in complaint case bearing No. 645 dated
5.8.2015 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act .

On 12.3.2018, following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner
contends that no independent FIR in terms of Section

174-A IPC has been registered against the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 2.5.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on 20.3.2018 and in the event of his appearance, he shall be enlarged on interim bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.”

Petitioner appeared before the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Kurukshetra on 19.3.2018 i.e. a day prior to the date fixed by this Court vide order dated 12.3.2018. Since the offence is bailable in nature, therefore, the petitioner was admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds on 19.3.2018. 20.4.2018 was the next date before the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class on the point of accusation. Petitioner again absented on 20.4.2018, therefore, his warrants of arrest and notice to surety were issued by the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class.

Petitioner has already surrendered before the trial Court on 1.5.2018 and was ordered to be kept in judicial custody. He was admitted to bail in a sum of ₹ 2 lacs with two sureties in the like amount. Penalty in the sum of ₹ 2,500/- was also imposed, which has been paid. Since the requisite bail

bonds were not furnished, therefore, the accused was ordered to be kept in judicial custody vide order dated 1.5.2018.

In view of the aforesaid facts, this petition has become infructuous. However, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Kurukshetra shall proceed to dispose of the pending bail application in accordance with law.

Dismissed as infructuous.
