The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.181 dated 11.04.2017 registered at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat under Sections 323/363/366A/376 of IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the statement made by Muskan, her medical record and also the interim orders.

Both the sides have been heard.

A complaint was made that two daughters of the complainant had been kidnapped by 5 persons. One of the girl was a minor. The minor returned home and told her family that she had been raped. She also made a complaint that her sister had been raped by 2-3 men. The elder girl, on recovery, made a statement that she had left home on her own and had married Sanjay, one of the accused and that she did not want to live with her

parents. The younger one was got medically examined. There was no reference to any injury or that she had been physically violated. A copy of the medical has been placed on record.

Considering the above position and also keeping in view the fact that both the girls are not appearing for their evidence and bailable warrants have been issued, bail is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
