Counsel for the petitioner has referred to the order dated 08.03.2018 passed by a coordinate Bench in the case of the petitioner i.e. CRM-M-9740-2018. He prays for the same order to be passed in the present case as the factual aspects are the same except for the cheque number and the date of issuance.

In view of the above keeping in view the fact that the petitioner states that because of the change of address, petitioner could not be served, rather he has never been served personally. In any case, petitioner is ready to join the proceedings before the trial Court and was not aware of the order passed by the trial Court declaring the petitioner a proclaimed offender.

Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court on or before 17.03.2018 and move an application for grant of bail before the trial Court.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and files an application for grant of regular bail, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail which shall operate till a decision is taken on the application for grant of regular bail.

The petition stands disposed of.
