Present petition under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code ('Cr.P.C.' - for short) has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 for protecting life and liberty of the petitioner and for providing safeguard to the petitioner from local anti-social elements, who wants to kill the petitioner and they attacked several times, due to local political rivalry, who are continuously harassing and threatening the petitioner as well as his family member with dire consequences and further issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to enquire the entire episode by any independent agency.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Despite repeated query by this Court, learned counsel for the petitioner is neither able to disclose as to from whom the petitioner is apprehending any threat to his life and liberty; nor he has impleaded any such person as party-respondents. Thus, there is no merit in the instant petition to issue any directions to the respondents.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to take recourse to other legal remedies available to him under law.
