Reply by way of affidavit of Harsimrat Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samrala, Punjab, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3, filed in Court today and same is taken on record.

Written statement alongwith Annexures, on behalf of respondent No. 5, filed in Court today and same is taken on record.

Heard.

Petitioner has filed petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing following directions :-

1. Respondents No. 2 and 3 be directed to attach properties of respondents No. 4 and 5 under Section 105 Cr.P.C. on the ground that these properties were purchased by said respondents by playing fraud to the tune of Rs. 5,72,00,000/- (approximately).

2. Administrator/Receiver (custodian) be appointed and land, FDR and bank accused be sized/attached as respondents No. 4 and 5 have embezzled/usurped amount which came temple from railway authorities and said amount has been misappropriated by respondents No. 4 and 5 by playing fraud.

These direction are sought under Section 105 Cr.P.C.

It comes out that FIR No. 67, dated 19.3.2017, registered at Police Station Samrala, Police District Khanna, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC.

At this stage, the learned counsel for petitioner has stated that as per reply, it is stated that they have already attached properties of respondents No. 4 and 5.

In view of above stand taken by respondents in reply, filed in Court today, the learned counsel for petitioner withdraws petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
