The petitioner-Gurtej Singh son of Sh. Raj Kumar, seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.197, dated 25.08.2017, under sections 124-A, 148, 149, 153-A, 186, 188, 307, 332, 353, 436, 506, 120-B IPC & sections 3 and 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 & sections 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 25.08.2017. The investigation is complete and the challan has already been presented. Co-accused similarly situated, as the petitioner, has already been granted bail and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody indefinitely.

The factual submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is not disputed by learned State counsel.

In view of the above and keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances of this case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner-Gurtej Singh son of Sh. Raj Kumar, is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Kaithal.
