On 15.01.2018, following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in respect of alleged incident of year 2014, the FIR in question came to be registered only on 01.10.2017 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur. Apparently, a civil suit for permanent injunction titled Kuldip Singh and another vs Pala Singh and others is pending consideration before the trial Court. Co-accused namely Davinderjit Singh @ Inderjit Singh and Manbir Singh have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M No.50154 of 2017 on 05.01.2018.

Notice of motion for 09.03.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear

before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 20.01.2018 at 11.00 A.M. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

At this stage, Mr. Peeush Gagneja, appears on behalf of the complainant.”

In compliance to the aforesaid order, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harbans Singh.

Learned counsel for the complainant however opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that huge amount has been swallowed by the petitioner.

Petitioner has joined the investigation. Civil suit for permanent injunction filed by the petitioner is pending before the trial Court. Co-accused namely Davinderjit Singh @ Inderjit Singh and Manbir Singh have already been granted anticipatory bail by the High Court.

Taking into consideration the totality of facts and circumstances of this case, at this stage, I deem it appropriate to confirm the interim order dated 15.01.2018. Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.
