Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.157 dated 02.12.2017, under Sections 326-A/325/323/506/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

Counsel would contend that it is a case of version and cross-version and as such it would be a matter of investigation to reveal as to who would be the aggressor party. Further contended that in the alleged occurrence even the petitioner has suffered injuries.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner concession of pre arrest bail.

FIR has been registered on the complaint of Shindo Bai in relation to an occurrence that took place on 20.11.2017. As per

complainant's version, the present petitioner was armed with a kirpan and attacked her husband, namely, Sham Singh and landed kirpan blows on his head.

Counsel for the petitioner has very fairly furnished for perusal of this Court the MLR of Sham Singh. Version of the complainant finds corroboration from the medical record. The injury suffered by Sham Singh on his head and which is specifically attributed to the petitioner who was stated to have been armed with kirpan has attracted offence under Section 325 IPC.

Keeping in view the serious allegations and gravity of offence, prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.

Petition dismissed.
