Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.136 dated 28.09.2017, under Sections 379-B, 506, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Instant petition came up for preliminary hearing before this Court on 12.01.2018 and while issuing notice of motion, petitioner was granted ad interim protection subject to his joining investigation. Matter was adjourned to 21.02.2018.

During the course of resumed hearing on 21.02.2018, State counsel had informed the Court that petitioner has not joined investigation. Accordingly, directions were issued for the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer on 28.02.2018 at 11:00 a.m. and the matter was adjourned to today.

State counsel upon instructions from ASI Shash Pal, Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar informs the Court that petitioner has chosen not to join investigation.

Counsel representing the petitioner is not in a position to rebut such assertion.

Conduct of the petitioner disentitles him from the concession of pre arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.

Needless to observe that the interim protection granted by this Court vide order dated 12.01.2018 would cease to operate.
