The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.156 dated 06.04.2017 registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Rajendera Park, Gurugram.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 05.04.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation on 14.04.2018 and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

On instructions from ASI Anil Kumar, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and stated that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer required.

In view of the above, the order dated 05.04.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

The amount of Rs. 50,000/- paid by the petitioner in terms of order dated 16.03.2018 is subject to the final decision of the criminal case.

Petition stands disposed off.
