Petitioner Ripujit Singh @ Ladda has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0157 dated 17.10.2017, registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel and learned counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

At the time of arguments, it has been brought to the notice of this Court that the parties have effected the compromise. Learned counsel for the complainant states that the parties have already effected the compromise in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the settlement has already been complied with. Both the learned counsel for the

parties admit this fact.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and the compromise effected between the parties; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
