On the complaint of the appellant, FIR No.63 dated 20.12.2011, was registered at Police Station Islamabad Amritsar, under section 306, 34 IPC.

The case of the prosecution is that in the night of 20.12.2011, the father of the complainant called him on his mobile phone to say that he was feeling distressed on account of conduct of the private respondent and thus, consumed some poisonous substance. Thereafter, the complainant along with two others reached the spot and found his father lying unconscious. He was taken to the hospital where he was declared brought dead.

The private respondents were summoned and tried in accordance with law. The trial Court has found that to establish abetment of suicide, instigation, conspiracy or doing any intentional act towards the commission of suicide is necessary. From the evidence on record, the prosecution has failed to prove the same and thus, the accused and private respondents were acquitted.

Learned counsel for the appellant has not been able to show that from the evidence on record, abetment of suicide has been proved and that the finding of learned trial Court is erroneous.

Thus, there is no merit in the appeal and the same is accordingly dismissed.
