Both the parties are *ad idem* to the effect that they have settled the dispute amicably. According to their settlement, respondent No.3-Insurance Company would pay ₹50,000/- to the appellant over and above the impugned award within 3 weeks.

In view of above settlement, respondent No.3-Insurance Company is directed to deposit the lump sum amount of ₹50,000/- within three weeks from today before the learned Tribunal for onward disbursement to the appellant in accordance with law against proper receipt and identification.

With the above observation, this appeal stands disposed of.
