Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.02 dated 19.01.2018, registered under Section 21/25/29/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station State Special Operation Cell, Fazilika, District Ferozepur.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, recovery of 300 grams heroin was effected from co-accused Gurdeep Singh from a bag that he was carrying and from the petitioner 10 grams heroin was recovered from his trouser pocket that he was wearing.

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Such recovery would be construed as non-commercial.
Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Disposed of.
