Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. challenging the order dated 25.8.2017 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Phillaur, by which the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in FIR No. 20 dated 3.4.2016 under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 307 and 325 added later on), registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.4.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Surinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has in fact surrendered before the Court.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and disposed of as such. Further, since the petitioner has already

appeared before the Trial Court, therefore, the impugned order declaring him to be proclaimed offender is also, formally, set aside.
