Petitioners seek issuance of necessary directions to respondent No.1 and 2 in the context of protection of their lives and personal liberties from being invaded at the hands of private respondents.

Petitioner No.1 is a widow. Marriage of son of petitioner No.1 was solemnized with Sanjana Rani-daughter of respondent No.4. The couple filed CRM-M No.7723 of 2018 which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 22.02.2018.

Petitioners have alleged that the private respondents have violated their civil rights on 24.04.2018 by entering into the house of the petitioners and assaulted them. They have also

taken some signatures on blank papers.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing any reply, as no order prejudicial to the interest of either party is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything in respect of allegations made in the present petition, I deem it appropriate to ask respondent No.2 to look into the representation already made by the petitioners before him on 26.02.2018 and to act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
