INDERJIT SINGH, J.(Oral)

Petitioners-Charno and Sandeep Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.209 dated 12.10.2016, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala, under Sections 306, 406 and 34 of IPC (later on summoned under Sections 306, 406, 201 and 120-B of IPC on the application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C.)

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the interim order dated 17.01.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already appeared before the trial Court and have been released on interim bail.

From the record, I find that the petitioners have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Now they are only to face the trial. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 17.01.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
