Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not misused the concession of interim bail earlier granted to him by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jind, on 06.04.2017, for the treatment of the petitioners' wife, even looking at the fact that the petitioner is the main accused, who is alleged to have fired the shot that killed the deceased. However, now, the learned Sessions Court has disallowed interim bail and directed that the petitioner be taken under police supervision to attend the 'kirya' ceremony of his father, who unfortunately died recently as per the petition.

I see no ground to interfere with that order, especially as the trial would be at a more advanced stage now, with the petitioner being one of the two main accused persons who are stated to have fired at the deceased.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.

However, nothing stated hereinabove will be taken to be a comment on the merits of the case, against or for the petitioner.
