Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 10 dated 16.2.2018 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he issued cheque in a sum of ₹ 2 lacs from a cheque book belonging to one Sumit Asija. The cheque was handed over to the complainant, namely, Navdeep Gumber. The complainant has already filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, in which the petitioner has already been summoned. FIR in question has been lodged against the petitioner for the offence under Section 420 IPC at the instance of Navdeep Gumber in which the petitioner seeks anticipatory

bail. The FIR was not lodged by Sumit Asija.

In view of above, let the petitioner appear before the Investigating Officer on 30.4.2018 and in the event of his appearance, he shall be enlarged on bail, on his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required.
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
