Petitioner seeks the benefit of regular bail in case F.I.R. No.205 dated 2.6.2017 under sections 386, 506, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Tosham, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Ajit Singh S/o Vijay Singh. It was alleged that the complainant was working in a wine company and on 01.06.2017, one Sonu Gurjar (co-accused) along with 4/5 other boys came to the office of the wine company in the late evening hours and demanded a sum of Rs.1 lakh to continue the business venture. At that stage, complainant telephoned his friends and whereupon the assailants fled away from the spot leaving their vehicle behind.

Present petitioner has not even been named in the FIR. He has been implicated on the strength of a supplementary statement recorded of the complainant on 28.06.2017.

Petitioner was arrested on 31.12.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan stands presented.

Trial would take time to conclude since it is at the very initial stage.

Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other criminal proceedings.

Co-accused Narender @ Dhillu and against whom there were similar allegations, has been granted benefit of bail by this Court in the light of order dated 24.1.2018 passed in CRM-M-44948-2017.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petition disposed of.
