Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos. 4 to 6 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 09.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, District Rupnagar-respondent No.2.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, District Rupnagar-respondent No.2 and the Station House Officer, P.S. Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar-respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 09.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, District Rupnagar-respondent No.2 and the Station House Officer, P.S. Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar-respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 09.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
