[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let a copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

[3]. In this petition, the petitioner seeks to release on bail in case FIR No.107 dated 09.05.2016, under Section 21/61/85 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Division No.7, District Ludhiana. He was already on bail in the case earlier but could not appear before the Ld. Trial Court on 08.02.2018, as according to him, on that date he was in custody in connection with some other case. On account of his inability not to appear before the Ld. Trial Court for this reason a non-bailable warrant of arrest was issued to secure his attendance.

[4]. In view of the grounds made out in the petition, the matter is disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Ld. Trial

Court within a week from date and seek fresh bail during this period execution of warrant issued against him shall remain stayed.

[5]. This order shall automatically stand vacated after 26.03.2018.
