ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No. 93 dated 18.05.2017, registered under Section 306, 120-B of IPC, Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioner no.1 is in custody since 18.05.2017 and petitioner no.2 is in custody since 05.09.2017 and charge had been framed and the complainant has been examined. The counsel urges that the death had taken place 9 years after marriage.

The State counsel states that there is a telephonic conversation, which was recorded between the deceased and her brother, which speaks about the role played by the mother-in-law.

The transcript placed on file today shows that the mother-in-law was not allowing the daughter-in-law to use the house-hold articles and used to take away even her clothes. The allegations were mainly against the husband who used to beat her.

The trial will take time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
