The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.63 dated 31.05.2017 under Sections 452/326/323/427/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

2. This Court vide order dated 04.04.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prem Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 04.04.2018 the petitioner has joined investigation. That apart observations made by this court in the order dated 04.04.2018 have gone un rebutted.

4. In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 04.04.2018, granting ad-

interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
