Perused the Case Diary and also the deposition of the complainant-
Vijay Kumar as PW-1 in the learned trial Court.

Admittedly, the petitioner was not named in the original FIR and even from the deposition of the complainant subsequently recorded in the learned trial Court, there is no allegation against him of having actually assaulted or even of having caught hold of the victim at the relevant time.

It further transpires that trial has now become somewhat delayed because an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. has been filed midway on behalf of the complainant.

Considering the over all circumstances mentioned above, the petitioner at this stage is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court with a further direction that he shall report himself at the local Police Station once a fortnight.
