Counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur on 16.03.2018 and on surrender, the petitioner would move an application for grant of regular bail, which may be considered and decided at an early date especially in the light of the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner although have been convicted but the sentence, which has been imposed, is Rs. 5,000/- fine and in default thereof, rigorous imprisonment of one month. This, the counsel states, on the basis of the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 24.07.2017 passed by the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur in the FIR, in which the petitioner was also an accused.

Keeping in view the statement of the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur on 16.03.2018.

In case, on surrender, the petitioner moves an application for

grant of regular bail, the same shall be considered and decided at an early date keeping in view the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner have been convicted and sentenced for only fine of Rs. 5,000/- each with a default clause of rigorous imprisonment of one month.
