This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, who was arrested on 5th October, 2017 in case FIR No.105 dated 28.09.2017, under Sections 304, 201 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Roopnagar, District Roopnagar.

2. It transpires that the investigation is already complete and challan has already been submitted. His co-accused Ram Pal has already been released on an anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M No.41823 of 2017.

3. Considering the overall circumstances which do not

indicate any clear intention on the part of the petitioner to commit the offence, at this stage, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
