Though otherwise neither the petitioner nor those on “his side”, nor those on the opposite side, deserve the concession of bail, all of them having resorted to attacking each other with deadly weapons, including *gandasis*, swords and fire arms etc., in a so called civilized society, however, since the matter has been compromised between the parties, as per the compromise deed, Annexure P-3, and various persons on the complainant side in the FIR (accused in the cross case), have already been admitted to bail, this petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
