On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes

to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to ask respondent No.2 to look into the matter and if any cognizable offence is found to have been committed, then in such an eventuality, respondent No.2 can be asked to act in accordance with law. If no cognizable offence is found to have been committed, then the complainant/petitioner be informed as per parameters laid down in **Lalita Kumari v. Govt. of U.P. (2014) 2 SCC (1).**

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
