The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.57 dated
18.06.2017, registered under Section 306 of IPC at Police Station Kathgarh,
District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that Kulwinder
Kaur and her daughter Jaskirat Kaur had committed suicide and on the last
date the case had been adjourned so that Daljit Singh could make a
statement. Counsel states that the examination-in-chief of the complainant
and the Uncle had already been recorded and Daljit Singh had turned hostile
who was to speak about the illicit relations between Gural Singh and the
petitioner.

The mother and son jumped into the canal and committed suicide. The allegations were that she suspected her husband of having illicit relations with the petitioner. Daljit Singh, Sarpanch of village Manewal who was the crucial witness has not supported the prosecution version and was turned hostile.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing surety and adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
