The present petition has been filed seeking protection of life and liberty as the petitioners fear that respondents No.4 to 6 (parents and other relatives of petitioner No.1) will cause them bodily harm as their marriage has been performed against their wishes.

2. Petitioners No. 1 and 2 are major and the same is proved by their Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2).

4. In view of above, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioners be protected by providing them adequate protection after carrying out a threat assessment and as and when deemed appropriate. The representation (Annexure P-4) already made as well as the facts mentioned in this petition shall be kept in mind by him.

5. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
