Pursuant to the order dated 09.07.2018, a copy of order dated 19.04.2018 passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in **Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No.3145/2018**, titled as **Shiv Kumar Vs. The State of Haryana**, has been placed on record. A perusal thereof shows that the cost of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) imposed by this Court has been reduced to Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the alleged damage to the property, total compensation of Rs.7,25,200/- has been worked out to be shared amongst 16 accused. The petitioners are willing to deposit their share of Rs.25,000/- each in terms of the order dated 19.04.2018, passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the trial is now complete and the

case is fixed for pronouncement of the order.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners controverts this statement by relying upon the order dated 19.07.2018, passed in CRM-M-30173-2018, whereby further proceedings have been stayed.

5. In view of the above and subject to deposit of Rs.25,000/- with the Department concerned, this petition is allowed and the petitioners- Balbir son of Sh. Hari Singh and Dharampal son of Sh. Dheerja, are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Kaithal.
