The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.157 dated 25.7.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 382, 392, 397, 465, 471 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") and 27 Arms Act (added lateron) at Police Station Phase-1, SAS Nagar.

Heard.

The petitioner is in custody since 25.7.2017.

Learned State counsel submits that recovery has already been effected and all the witnesses turned hostile.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Manjinder Pal Singh son of Shri Jaswant Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to the conditions, if any, and on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the

Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
