AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

As per the learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Inder Singh, the petitioner and those on his side have suffered more injuries than are stated to have been inflicted by the petitioner and his co-accused on the complainant in the FIR, with a cross-case also registered.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, which would be gone into by the investigating agency and the trial Court at the appropriate stage, since the petitioner is also shown to be 73 years old, I consider it appropriate that upon him joining investigation, if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on bail, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Illaq Magistrate, during the pendency of the investigation.
